ULTIMATE WATERSPORTS RELEASE AGREEMENT

- ⇒ The participants and parents attest that the participant is physically fit and possesses the physical strength to meet his/her responsibilities as an alpine snowboarder/skier and will not participate in the sport while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- ⇒ Ultimate Watersports is not responsible for lost or stolen lift tickets.
- ⇒ **Lift tickets are not transferable.**
- ⇒ We expect courtesy and respect among all of our skiers and snowboarders to preserve the enjoyment of the sport.
- ⇒ All fencing, poles, signage and other marking devices are in place to inform you of potential hazards or obstacles. The markers will not protect you from injury and it is your responsibility to stay away from marked areas.

SKIER / SNOWBOARDER RESPONSIBILITY CODE & AGREEMENT

1. Always stay in control and be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.
2. People ahead or downhill of you have the right of way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
3. Whenever starting downhill or merging into a trail, look uphill and yield to others.
4. You must not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.
5. Always use devices to prevent runaway equipment.
6. Observe all posted signs and warnings. Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
7. Prior to using any lift, you must have the ability to load and unload safely. Do not jump from the lift. In the event of a prolonged stoppage the Ski Patrol will evacuate you.
8. Do not go down trails that are too difficult for your ability.
9. Skiing is a positive environmental experience. All participants should make every effort to care for the environment while enjoying the sport of alpine snowboarding/skiing. Please do not litter.
10. All participants are responsible for their own equipment and personal belongings. Ultimate Watersports and Ski Roundtop are not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
11. If you have a collision resulting in injury to another person you must stay with that person until Ski Patrol Arrives.
12. I will make no misrepresentations concerning my or my child's height, weight, age or snowboarding/skier type.
13. I agree to hold harmless and indemnify from any and all liability, regardless of negligence, Ultimate Watersports, Ski Roundtop, their owners, agents and employees, as well as the equipment manufacturers and distributors, for any loss or damage, including, but not limited to, any that results from claims for personal injury, death related to the use of the equipment.
14. I understand that there are inherent and other risks involved in the sport of snowboarding/skiing and that injuries are a common and ordinary occurrence of the sport, and I freely and voluntarily assume those risks.
15. I understand that a ski-binding-boot system will not release at all times or under all circumstances where release may prevent injury or death, nor it is possible to predict every situation in which it will release, and there is, therefore, no guarantee of safety. I further understand that a snowboard binding and boot system will not ordinarily release during use, nor is it specifically designed to release as a result of a fall, therefore providing no guarantee of safety.
16. I hereby agree to release, hold harmless and indemnify Ultimate Watersports, Ski Roundtop Operating Corp., their owners, agents and employees, as well as the manufacturers and distributors of the rental equipment from any and all liability for damage, injury or death to myself, my child or to any person or property resulting from the selection, installation, maintenance, adjustment or use of said rental equipment and for any claim based upon negligence, breach of warranty, contract, or other legal theory.
17. To the extent permitted by law, I agree to hold harmless and indemnify Ultimate Watersports, Ski Roundtop, Ski Roundtop's Ski School, including its Instructors, from any and all liability, regardless of any negligence for damage and injury to myself, my child or any person or property that occurs while I am taking a Ski School lesson.
18. I understand and agree that terrain parks and half pipes are not a normal part of snowboarding/skiing and that the use of features in said parks may present an increased risk of serious injury or death. I further understand and agree that when entering said parks I agree to release, hold harmless and indemnify Ultimate Watersports, Ski Roundtop, their owners, agents and employees, from any and all liability, regardless of any negligence, for any loss related to the use of said terrain parks. I agree to wear a properly fitted ski or snowboard helmet while in the terrain parks and halfpipe.
19. I fully understand and agree that alpine snowboarding/skiing in its various forms, including the use of lifts, is a dangerous sport with inherent risks that could lead to permanent catastrophic injury or death. Said risks are explained in more detail in the area brochure and on the back of the lift ticket. In consideration of using Ski Roundtop's facilities, I agree to accept the risks involved, understanding that snowboarding/skiing is hazardous and agree not to sue Ultimate Watersports, Ski Roundtop, their owners, agents or employees if injured while using said facilities, regardless of any negligence on the part of the same.
20. I agree, on behalf of myself or my child to report all injuries to the Ultimate Watersports Staff and the Roundtop Ski Patrol, before leaving the area.
