

## **Location Manager**

**Summary:** This full-time or part-time (site dependent) seasonal position is responsible for the coordination and operation of a particular location. Site Managers are expected to supervise the safety of the guests and staff in their programs and provide mentorship for Instructors, Front Desk, and Beach Hands. ## **Minimum Qualifications:**

- 21 years of age
- Familiarity with all water sports offered
- Current Lifeguard certification
- Current First Aid and CPR/AED certifications
- Previous experience in a management position
- Ability to multi-task including instruction, risk management, and equipment management
- Knowledge and experience with Microsoft Office and Google products
- Must provide own transportation
- Ability to move equipment in excess of 50lbs.

## **Desired Qualifications:**

- Current certification from American Canoe Association (ACA), American Sailing Association (ASA), and/or US Sailing in kayaking, stand-up paddle boarding, windsurfing, and/or small boat sailing
- Knowledge and experience with QuickBooks software
- Understanding of local weather conditions
- Ability to mentor all staff in conduct

## **Overview of Duties:**

- 1. Assumes responsibility for all safety considerations for each day
- 2. Stage watercraft for start of daily operations
- 3. Re-rack and lock all watercraft at the end of daily operations
- 4. Set-up office and computer for start of daily operations
- 5. Activate, test, and put all radio in dry bags for the day
- 6. Answer questions regarding programs
- 7. Accept registration, payment, and refunds for programs
- 8. Supervise and check End-of-Day and Daily Business Report (DBR)
- 9. Fit guests properly for PFDs, paddles, kayaks, and paddleboards
- 10. Explain boundaries and suggested routes to all guests at time of launch
- 11. Meet guests returning from excursion to collect all equipment and re-stage
- 12. Participate in daily debrief and issue reconciliation
- 13. Assist with weekly equipment and site safety checks
- 14. Display a constant positive attitude toward guests and staff
- 15. Reports to General Manager

**Salary and Benefits:** Approximately 45 hours per week. Compensation is paid on an hourly basis commensurate with education and experience. Payment occurs on the 15<sup>th</sup> and last of the month. One week of unpaid vacation is allotted between Memorial Day and Labor Day.
